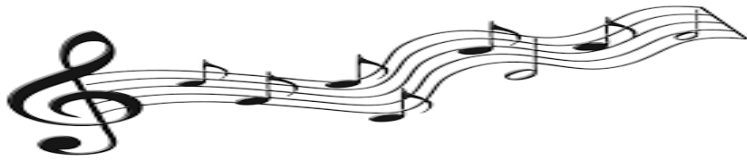


Performing Arts at S.A.M.P.S
